Re-announcement of the JASSO Scholarship in Kumamoto University (Under IJEP Short Term Exchange Program-2026)

The International Collaboration and External Affairs Office (ICEAO), the Noakhali Science and Technology University (NSTU) is delighted to inform all concerned that the Graduate School of Science and Technology (GSST), Kumamoto University, Japan has invited applications from the qualified students of the designated departments of the NSTU for participating in the IJEP Short Term Exchange Program with JASSO Scholarship to study master's course in the aforesaid University for the period of six months to eleven months for the Fall Semester commencing from October 1, 2026.

Required Qualification

The students interested for participating in this exchange program should have at least the CGPA of 3.50 in the Bachelor program or the TGPA of 3.50 in the first term of the Master's Exam along with the CGPA of 3.50 in the Bachelor Program, adequate English proficiency, and a valid passport. Please be informed that as per the norms of the scholarship, the applicants should have a valid IELTS score (overall band score of 6.0) or TOEFL score (PBT 530 or equivalent in IBT). Hence, the applicants having a valid IELTS or TOEFL score, may be prioritized or their educational qualification, especially the CGPA at the undergraduate level may be relaxed up to 3.35.

How to Apply

The interested students have to send their applications in a prescribed form with a recommendation letter from their respective chairman, the attested copies of all academic transcripts, and the proofs of other relevant certificates and achievements (e.g. the medium of instructions, Master's enrolment certificate, research paper, co-curricular activities, recognitions, and so on) via email (rokonsiddiky.soc@nstu.edu.bd) by April 16, 2026. While sending applications, the applicants are required to put CC to ICEA Office (international@office.nstu.edu.bd). Please also note that the NSTU authority reserves all the rights in this selection process.

Important Instructions

Please note that while submitting the applications via email, the applicants have to merge all the academic documents along with passport copy in order and transform them into a single pdf file while other documents such as the copies of the research papers and certificates of co-curricular activities have to be sent merging together into a separate file via the same email.
