Announcement for the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility Program for Training-2025 in Amasya University, Turkiye

The costs associated with this mobility program will be borne by the host University as per the EU guidelines. Please note that one (01) non-academic staff will be selected via proper process under this program and the period of the program may vary depending on the situation, and obtaining of the Turkish visa by the participants.
